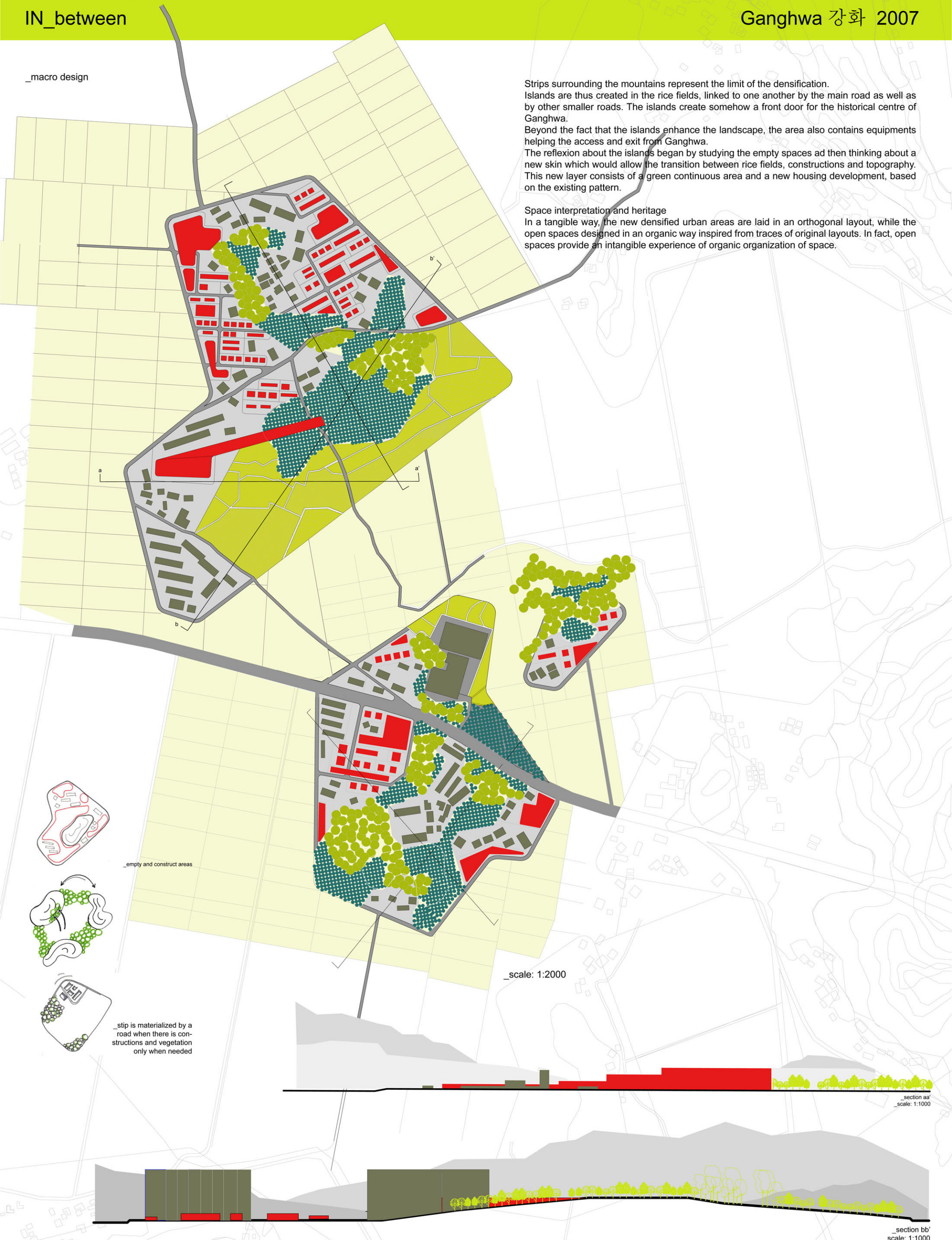

Strips surrounding the mountains represent the limit of the densification. Islands are thus created in the rice fields, linked to one another by the main road as well as by other smaller roads. The islands create somehow a front door for the historical centre of Ganghwa.
 Beyond the fact that the islands enhance the landscape, the area also contains equipments helping the access and exit from Ganghwa.
 The reflexion about the islands began by studying the empty spaces and then thinking about a new skin which would allow the transition between rice fields, constructions and topography. This new layer consists of a green continuous area and a new housing development, based on the existing pattern.

Space interpretation and heritage
 In a tangible way, the new densified urban areas are laid in an orthogonal layout, while the open spaces designed in an organic way inspired from traces of original layouts. In fact, open spaces provide an intangible experience of organic organization of space.
